Sunday School Teacher

Position Purpose

Our children need the leadership of Christian adults who will guide them as they grow in their understanding of themselves, of God, of God's love shown through Jesus Christ, of God's church, and of the church's mission.

Ministry Description

1. Guide, model, and be a friend to each student. There are approximately 8-10 children per class, depending on their age.
2. Know the curriculum; preparation for leading the class is to be done ahead of class time.
3. Arrive at least 10-15 minutes before your class begins to prepare your classroom and activities.
4. Regularly attend teacher's meetings for Bible study, fellowship, and planning.
5. Coordinate responsibilities with co-teacher or Sunday school aide in your class.

Timeframe

The commitment is for the school year, each Sunday for one hour. Preparation time can take from one to three hours. Teacher's meetings are held approximately once a quarter.

You will develop your Bible knowledge and sharpen your creative teaching, storytelling, listening, and communication skills.
