Eucharistic Ministry

Position Purpose

This service of care takes communion to church shut-ins and to members who may be hospitalized or home-bound with an illness or injury.

Ministry Description

1. Contact shut in or home-bound members, and members who may be in the hospital, living in a convalescent center, etc., and set up a time to visit and take them communion..
2. Let the Discipleship Coordinator know if the member that has been seen needs any further attention.

Timeframe

The shut-in members should be seen once month.

Skills to Be Used/Developed

Training/Resources

Training will be provided by the Pastor of Nurture and Outreach. Resources available include: Communion Boxes will available to all who make visits. The communion wafers and wine can be refilled after any regular church service or through the church office.
